Are you advised by Eye hospital to go for Cataract Surgery?

If so please note the following Advisory.

The Eye Hospitals will prescribe medicines (Eye Drops) costing around Rs2000 as pre and post operative Surgery.

If you purchase the medicines from the hospital by making payment you may be able to claim from UTIITSL through its portal. Hope it may be reimbursed.

But one can get the prescription from the eye hospital and get the medicines from CGHS wellness centres if you plan the date of surgery accordingly.

This can avoid spending from your pocket and claiming subsequently through UTIITSL Portal

Package

Each eye hospital will have a Package depending upon the NABH or Non NABH accreditation.

If one desires to have better quality lens, the difference amount should be borne by the patient.

In one case, the hospital is NABH accredited and their Package is Rs17000 which they will claim from UTIITSL.

Since he selected a better quality lens which was costing Rs37000, he was asked to pay Rs20000 cash direct to hospital.

The cost may vary from hospital to hospital.
